1. ANNOUNCEMENT

The Moto Club Bergamo in collaboration with the Fédération International de Motocyclisme (FIM) will organise the 2025 FIM International Six Days of Enduro (ISDE 2025 Italy) on behalf of the Federazione Motociclistica Italiana (FMI).

The event will be held in accordance with the FIM Sporting Code together with relevant appendices, including other Codes and Regulations FIM. These Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions are approved by Race Direction and the FIM Stewards Panel.

The event will be held on 24-29 August 2025 in the city of Bergamo, province of Bergamo, Italy.

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2. OPENING HOURS OF THE ISDE SECRETARIAT

The ISDE Secretariat will be located in the Fiera di Bergamo (Bergamo) in the paddock and will be open on 18 August 2025, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. and the following days according to the official schedule.

3. REGISTRATION PROCESS AND ENTRIES

The registrations will be made only via the ISDE website <u>www.fim-isde.com</u>. "Registration". The pre-registrations will be considered only if the payment of 50% of the entry fee has been done according to the FIM regulations.

After this deadline, the FMNs that will not have paid the pre-registration amount or FMNs wishing to add teams over its pre-registration quota (see below) will have to pay the total entry fee (100%) before <u>6 June 2025</u>

The Federations will receive by e-mail the teams number accepted by nation by <u>**20 Apr 2025**</u>. In case of rejection of riders and teams, the pre-paid 50% entry fee will be refunded, within 14 days after the rejection.

3.1 ENTRIES

FIM WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS FOR NATIONAL TEAMS

THE FIM WORLD TROPHY (WT)

Each FMN may enter one national WT team composed of **four riders**. Each of these riders must be holder of a passport* of the country which he represents.

THE FIM JUNIOR WORLD TROPHY (JWT)

Each FMN may enter one national JWT team composed of **three riders**. Each of these riders must be under the age of 23 years old (at 1 January 2025) and holder of a passport* of the country which he represents.

THE FIM WOMEN'S WORLD TROPHY (WWT)

Each FMN may enter one national WWT team composed of **three women riders**. Each of these riders must be holder of a passport* of the country which she represents.











FIM WORLD CUP FOR NATIONAL CLUB TEAMS

THE FIM CLUB TEAM AWARDS (CTA)

Each FMN may enter one or more CTA team(s) composed of **three riders**. Each of these riders must be nominated by a bona fide moto club or FMN and must be holder of a passport* of the country which he/she represents. They may also be of different nationalities but under the same FIM Continental Union. In such case, the FMN of each rider must give its approval and the CTA must be entered by the FMN of one of these riders.

THE FIM WOMEN'S CLUB TEAM AWARDS (CTA)

Each FMN may enter one or more WOMEN'S CTA team(s) composed of **three riders**. Each of these riders must be nominated by a bona fide moto club or FMN and must be holder of a passport* of the country which she represents. They may also be of different nationalities but under the same FIM Continental Union. In such case, the FMN of each rider must give its approval and the CTA must be entered by the FMN of one of these riders.

THE FIM VETERAN CLUB TEAM AWARDS (CTA)

Each FMN may enter one or more VETERAN CTA team(s) composed of **three riders**. Each of these riders must be aged at least 50 years old (at 1 January 2025). Each of these riders must be nominated by a bona fide moto club or FMN and must be holder of a passport* of the country which he/she represents. They may also be of different nationalities but under the same FIM Continental Union. In such case, the FMN of each rider must give its approval and the CTA must be entered by the FMN of one of these riders.

(*passport, or an ID-Card, if the ID card clearly shows the rider's nationality, of the country which the rider represents)

A rider registration is fully confirmed when the FMN has paid 100% of the registration fee that must be effective the latest at the deadline date for payment above mentioned: 6 June 2025.

According to the art. 061.33 of the 2025 FIM ISDE Regulations, the following principles apply:

- If an FMN cancels a pre-registration in writing before **6 June 2025** then the Local Organizer will keep 25% of the total registration fee and refund the remaining 75% the latest one month after the written demand has been made.
- If an FMN cancels a registration after **6 June 2025**, then the Local Organizer will keep 100% of the amount paid by the FMN.
- As long as an FMN has paid 100% of the amount of the registration fee, the FMN has the possibility to replace a rider by another until the last day before the race.

For all payments done after **6 June 2025**, an extra EUR 50,00 per rider registration concerned by the late payment will be charge to the FMN.

6. CAMERA ACCESS AND VIDEO ACCREDITATION

According to Art.3.4 of the FIM Statutes, the FIM is the sole owner of the Media rights for the FIM International Six Days of Enduro. The FIM delivers and sells the footage & videos produced by FIM TV.

In order to guarantee the standards of the FIM World Championships images, the FIM gives priority to providing footage filmed and videos produced by FIM TV. The deadline to order a FIM ISDE Video product is **6 June 2025**.

FMNs with at least one of the Trophy's categories registered can benefit with one Video Accreditation including a Camera Access for free. In any case, the Camera Access will be subject to Video Accreditation in due time. The FMNs can request additional Camera Access following the proper procedure.

Any other third parties (including Club Team Awards) willing to receive a Video Accreditation including a Camera Access must follow the proper procedure and will be subject to an additional fee.

8. SHIPPING &LOGISTIC

Due to shipping costs important increase, it is difficult for the organizer to propose a competitive solution for shipping and logistic. The FMNs or other structures are invited to manage by themselves shipping solutions.

For paddock set up, the organizer will propose a truck crane service to install / uninstall containers as well as container rental service. The Teams and FMNs will have to pay the fee (to be defined at a later stage) directly to the indicated service provider.

- Dismantling dates for container: Saturday 30 August from 8:00 to 21:00 and Sunday 31 August 2025 from 08:00 to 12:00.

10. WEIGHT RENTAL

As it is forbidden to drill the asphalt in all the Bergamo Trade Show venue (paddock A, paddock B, for more info see Art. 12 + 13), the teams are invited to bring their own weights to secure their structures.

11. OFFICIAL RACING SERVICES AND OTHER SERVICES

Teams and riders have access to Official Racing Services:

- Motorcycle rental and assistance services managed by the Enduro Manufacturer Factories or authorised specialized racing structures in order to ease their logistic issues.
- Tyres racing services
- Other racing services to be specified at a later stage.

Teams and riders are welcome to book the Racing Services they wish to benefit from in advance as generally speaking, a pre-order is requested to access those services.









Important notice: Only Official Racing Services approved by FIM can provide you with a highquality, guaranteed service at the event.

12. PADDOCK A / RACING PADDOCK

The Paddock A will be located at the Fiera di Bergamo trade show in the city of Bergamo and will be open from Monday, 18 August 2025, at 8:00 until Sunday 31 August 2025, at 12:00.

PADDOCK A OPENING HOURS

- Monday 18 August to Saturday 23 August: 08:00 to 21:00
- Sunday 24 August to Friday 29 August: 06:30 to 22:00
- Saturday 30 August: 06:30 to 21:00
- Sunday 31 August: 6:30 to 12:00

Each Structure (FMN or entity managing one or several Teams) will receive a surface in the Racing Paddock (Paddock A) according to the number of riders they intend to register:

- 1,5 linear meters per rider.
- 12m in depth as a maximum for Nation Teams, 6m in depth for Club Teams
- An extra surface of 3m depth behind each structure will be allocated for team's assistance and staff vehicles to access their structures in the morning before the race and afternoon after the race, as a temporary parking places. After the services times, the team assistance and staff vehicles must be parked in the team's assistance and staff vehicles parking.
- For FMNs/Countries/Teams whom riders are 100% managed by an Official Racing Service will not receive an additional surface in the Paddock A.

After the Pre-Registrations, the Structure will be requested to fill a document concerning their needs in the Paddock and the number and team names managed with their plan corresponding to the allocated surface depending on the number of teams and riders managed.

This document will be sent on **21 April 2025** and must be sent back by email to <u>6days.paddock@motoclub.bergamo.it</u> and <u>fim.mkt.consultant@gmail.com</u> with the structure plan by **30 May 2025** the latest.

Each team's surface in the paddock will have access to water and electricity connection.

The power supplied (**) depends on the dimension of the surface allocated. **To be confirmed at a later stage.

It is also possible to get a 380 v-three-phase electric alimentation included for free under 2 conditions: the structure must make the demand the latest on 10 May 2025 and justify such kind of demand for the organizer to accept it. After 10 May 2025, this possibility will not be accessible.

As the connections may be distant, it is up to the team to bring their own extension cords minimum 50m. For the type of connections required, please see <u>Appendix 2 - Technical requirements for electricity</u> <u>and water connections</u>.

In case a structure needs an additional surface in the paddock, it is possible to purchase it.

Please see Appendix 3 - Options for additional needs not included in rider registration fee.

RACING PADDOCK / PADDOCK A RULES

- It is forbidden to stay at the Paddock A during the night, unless the vehicle in the Paddock A is equipped with the suitable facilities sleeping beth.
- Campers, camping cars, etc. are not allowed in the Racing Paddock / Paddock A. Those vehicles category have to park in the paddock B or to a suitable camping area to benefit from comfort and all facilities, the one proposed in the paddock B will be limited compared to a real camping.
- In the Paddock A it is not authorized to pick sticks or nails, to drill. Teams must bring their own weights to secure their structure.
- In the paddock A it is forbidden to use barbecue or similar items.
- It is possible to cook inside each allocated surface if the following 2 constrains are strictly respected:
- 1. It is strictly forbidden to dump your waste waters on the ground. Failure in applying this rule while expose you to direct prosecution by the competent local authorities (environment police). Each Structures are encouraged to collect their wastewater and dispose of it at designated wastewater areas in the paddock, as indicated on the environmental map. (to be published at a later stage).
- 2. The structure electrical needs must not overcome the allocated power supplied. In case of anticipated additional needs, the structure has to make the demand to the organizer for additional surface / power supply by 10 May 2025 the latest (see Appendix 3). After this deadline the organizer will not be able to answer to additional needs and the structure will have to adapt with the pre-defined level of power supplied.
- In case a structure needs a specific hospitality area independent from the racing structure, this service is not included in the registration fee. It is necessary to contact the organizer / paddock manager <u>6days.paddock@motoclub.bergamo.it</u> and <u>fim.mkt.consultant@gmail.com</u> to express their needs. A fee will be calculated accordingly and proposed to the concerned Structure. This fee must be accepted and paid by **13 June 2025** the latest.

There will not be charges for Teams bringing their own racing / assistance service for the riders they manage as long as it is not a commercial activity, E.g. a Structure or Team selling assistance service or bike rental to riders wherever they are coming from.

13. PADDOCK B / SLEEPING PADDOCK

The paddock B will be located at Fiera di Bergamo trade show in Bergamo city and will be open from Monday, August 18, 2025 at 08:00 to Saturday, August 30, 2025 at 21:00.

As the area is limited in the Paddock B, the teams wishing to benefit from a space in the paddock B, must fill and send the Paddock Form to <u>6days.paddock@motoclub.bergamo.it</u> no later than the **21 April**. The confirmation of the area granted will be sent to the applying teams the **30 May** the latest.

The area granted in the Paddock B for a club Team of 3 riders is 10m x 10m. For teams composed of more riders, the concerned entity must precise the number of riders and its demand. The organizer will study the demand and answer on the surface granted the **30 May** the latest.

As the electric and water connections may be distant from their Paddock B place, it is up to the team to bring their own extension cords minimum 50 m. For the type of connections required, please see <u>Appendix</u> <u>2 - Technical requirements for electricity and water connections</u>.

SLEEPING PADDOCK / PADDOCK B RULES

- In the Paddock B it is not authorized to pick sticks or nails, to drill. Teams must bring their own weights to secure their structure (see article 10).
- In the paddock B it is forbidden to use barbecue or similar items.
- It is possible to cook inside each allocated surface if the following 2 constrains are strictly respected:
- 1. It is strictly forbidden to dump your waste waters on the ground. Failure in applying this rule while expose you to direct prosecution by the competent local authorities (environment police). Each Structures are encouraged to collect their wastewater and dispose of it at designated wastewater areas in the paddock, as indicated on the environmental map. (to be published at a later stage).
- 2. The structure electrical needs must not overcome the allocated power supplied. The structure will have to adapt with the pre-defined level of power supplied.

14. PARC FERME

The Parc Fermé will be located at Fiera di Bergamo (Bergamo)

Each rider must be equipped with an environmental mat under the motorcycle compliant with the FIM Environmental Code (Article 4.1 Environmental Mat).

The environmental mat must remain in the Parc Fermé for the duration of the event.

Outside the Parc Fermé (paddock structure, working area and control of attendance times), FMNs, teams and riders must use their own environmental mat.









15. ADMINISTRATIVE AND TECHNICAL INSPECTION

The Federations must enter the riders' complete details (FIM license number, insurance, etc.) via the online application provided by the FIM by the **6 June 2025** the latest. All FMNs should make their best effort to fill completely the application forms as soon as possible, so that the FIM and Local Organiser can promote efficiently their participating teams and riders.

The administrative and technical inspection will take place in **the Paddock (Fiera di Bergamo trade show - Bergamo city)**, on Thursday 21 August 2025 from 8:30 to 18:00, on Friday 22 August 2025 from 8:30 to 16:30 and on Saturday 23 August 2025 from 08:30 to 14:00.

ITALY, the hosting country will have to pass the Administrative and Technical Inspection on Saturday morning. All other countries will have to pass the Administrative and Technical Inspection on Thursday and Friday.

The timetable of the Administrative and Technical Inspection for each country will be posted on the Official Notice Board/Sportity **7 August 2025**.

Overseas motorcycles Insurance:

The Local Organizer will provide a policy, but the Motorcycles must have to be registered in their country (Europe, Africa, Australia, New Zeeland, Chili, etc.).

To get insurance they must have vehicle registration papers and original registration plate, otherwise the motorcycles cannot be insured.

The original number plate must be fixed on the rear mud guard.

Incoming temporary insurance policies rates: to be confirmed at a later stage.

- Riders' requirements and documents needed for the administrative inspection:
- FIM license issued for this event,
- Valid driving license,
- Passport (or ID card),
- Entry fee total payment confirmation,
- Original registration certificate of the bike (with frame number) and the vehicle registration plate,
- The international insurance certificate of the motorbike used for the competition valid for Italy, in accordance with the requirements of article L211-1 of the European insurance code. The validity for Europe and the compliance with the requirements of article L211- 1 of the European insurance code must be explicitly written on the document presented.

Should the rider not to have a valid insurance certificate meeting the 2 criteria above mentioned, The Local Organizer requires the bike to be registered with an Italian insurance company (at the expense of the rider). The Organizer will propose an insurance with the possibility of subscribing on the event at the conditions mentioned in the previous paragraph "insurance overseas motorcycles".

The riders must also sign the signing-on form at the administrative inspections.

At the administrative inspection, the FMNs or Structure integrating one or several Club Teams will receive the following passes. <u>Please note that according to articles 5 and 6 the media and camera pass delivery are subject to the conditions expressed in those 2 articles</u>

For the Final Cross Test on Day 6 / Friday 29 August 2025, the access to Final Cross Test will require the purchase of tickets (more information will be provided at a later stage).

All individuals with a Team / Staff pass will have free access.

16. CLASSES

The classes of the ISDE for solo motorcycles are:

- Enduro 1: Up to 250cc 2 stroke and 4 stroke
- Enduro 2: From 255cc to 450cc 4 stroke
- Enduro 3: Over 255cc 2 stroke and over 455cc 4 stroke

Any motorcycle coming within classes of Category I, Group A1 and Category 2, Group C shall be eligible for entry.



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17. OFFICIAL TRAINING AREA

The training area will be located at 1 Km. from the Paddock at Fiera di Bergamo (Bergamo). Location will be announced at a later stage.

Its access will be duly signed, and internal direction will be signed with ribbons and arrows. More information will be provided at a later stage.

18. ADVERTISING

It is strictly forbidden to place any advertising (banners, balloons, boards, flags, etc.) at the ISDE venue (secretariat, paddock area, parking lots, special test tracks, official route and any other places related to the event).

FMNs and Structures integrating one or several Club Teams are free to display advertising in the allocated places in the paddock, working area and service time checks under the conditions described thereafter.

Vertical branding (beach flags, pole on structures' top / roof, inflated tools) and horizontal branding (banners on the perimeter of the structure, oil barrels) are only authorized for the materials including the following element: country flag, FMN logo, Moto Club logo OR mixed materials with at least minimum 30% of the surface with team name (or country logo, FMN logo, Moto Club logo) and 70% maximum of the remaining area with the team's partners logo.

In no case the vertical or horizontal materials composed with only one sponsor brand are authorized. Inside the structure perimeter, the branding is free.

19. ENVIRONMENT

Each rider must be equipped with an environmental mat under the motorcycle compliant with the FIM Environmental Code (Article 4.1 Environmental Mat).

A working fire extinguisher is mandatory at each service area.

20. NUMBER PLATES AND STARTING ORDER

Number plates and starting order will follow the FIM regulations.

The whole number plates surface, front and sides is reserved to the FIM and the Local Organizer. No additional branding or hiding a part of the plate number surface is allowed.

FIM will supply **on 21 April 2025** at the latest the files (PDF HD format) of the official templates of the number plates stickers for the different categories (WT, JWT, WWT and CTA).

In any case, each rider will receive during the Administrative Inspection the 3 number plates stickers (one front, 2 sides) corresponding to his category.

21. OPENING CEREMONY

The Opening Ceremony will take place in **Piazza Giacomo Matteotti (Bergamo)** on Friday 22 August at 19:00. The Local Organizer will give precise instructions and running order for the nation's parade and activities during the ceremony.

During the parade and in the welcome zone in front of the stage, FMN, Teams, Clubs are encouraged to show their colours (flags, etc.). No commercial items (commercial brand flags or any other material) are allowed.

It is compulsory for all the participants to stay in the welcome zone in front of the stage, from the start to the end of the official ceremony.









22. COURSE

The race will begin on Sunday 24 August and will end on Friday 29, August 2025. The total length of the route, including special tests, will be around 220 Km per day.

From day 1 to day 5, the course will be composed of 3 different tracks with a growing difficulty:

- Day 1: 1 ½ laps, medium difficulty
- Day 2 and Day 3: 1 lap, medium difficulty
- Day 4 and Day 5: 2 laps, medium / high difficulty

On day 6, riders will do several laps of the Final Cross Test, the exact number will be announced at the end of Day 5.

The final Cross Test will be located at Covo MX Track, 30 Km from the Paddock.

There will be a maximum of 3 Service Time Checks (STC) outside the paddock. 1 Service Time Check inside the Paddock at end of each days of racing.

Each FMN / Structure managing one or several Club Teams benefits from a surface on each spot of Service Time Checks depending on the number of teams and riders managed: please refer to <u>Appendix</u> **1** - Racing facilities included in rider registration fee.

Important information:

Walking, cycling or riding are not allowed before 8 days before the start of ISDE (August 15, 2025). Starting from the 16 August, it is allowed to walk the tests (only by foot). Any violation of this rule, prior to the timed test, if it is reported, accepted and confirmed to the Race Direction that a rider was observed walking or performing a Special Test before the time assigned for it, that rider may be sanctioned. is liable for a penalty in accordance with the FIM Disciplinary and Arbitration Code. The sanction must be proportional to the infraction, the circumstances (mitigating or aggravating where applicable) and taking into account the possible advantage obtained by the rider.

23. HIGHWAY CODE FOR OPERATION ON PRIVATE HIGHWAYS AND PUBLIC ROADS

All riders and participants in the event must respect the national traffic code for operation on all public and private roads and road crossings. They must conform to all instructions that are given by police, by the traffic marshals and by the race management. Riders failing to observe these instructions may be disqualified from the event or face other penalties of the sporting code.









24. FUEL AND TYRES

Any fuel used must be in conformity with the article 01.63 of the FIM Technical Regulations for Enduro.

All tyres used on the competition motorcycles must comply with the article 01.51 of the FIM Technical Regulations for Enduro.

Fuel will not be available in the paddock. There is a service station located at 50 m from the paddock.

25. INTERPRETATION OF REGULATIONS AND RULES

The interpretation of the FIM regulations and rules for ISDE and of the supplementary Regulation approved for this event is in the competency of the sporting jurisdiction approved by the FIM for this event.

26. CLOSING CEREMONY AND AWARDS

The prize-giving ceremony will take place on the podium after the Final Cross Test on, Friday 29 August, the podium will be located at the Covo MX Track. The prize giving ceremony will be splits in 2 key moments:

- End of the Morning, around noon: brand challenges and Club Team Awards ceremony.
- End of the Afternoon, not later than 5 pm: Trophy categories and other awards.

27. 6 DAYS PARTY

After the Closing Ceremony and Awards on Friday 29 August 2025, the 6Days Party will be organized.

Further details will be communicated at a later stage.

28. INSURANCE

The insurance of the participants is regulated by the provisions of Article 110.1.1 and 110.3 of the FIM Sporting Code and Article 061.65 of the FIM ISDE Regulations.

29. TRANSPONDERS

Transponders will be distributed before entering the Parc-Fermé according to the timetable assigned to each country for proceeding with the technical inspection.

Riders will be able to buy transponder holders at the administrative office.

The riders having lost or forgotten their transponder will pay an amount of EUR 250.00.

The transponders will be collected back by the Local Organizer at the end of the race on the exit of the Final Cross Test.









30. OFFICIAL NOTICE BOARD

The FIM and Local Organizer will employ the use of Sportity mobile app to host all the sporting documents for the entire event. Please enable notifications on the app after you install it to ensure you receive the latest notifications when documents are uploaded. A token that all competitors can use to access the event Channel will be available at the administrative control.

There will be no physical Official Notice Board at the ISDE HQ. The Official Notice Board is the SPORTITY Application.
